


STUDENT THRESHOLDS

EASILY SEE STUDENTS WHO MEET SPECIFIC RULE THRESHOLDS TO ENSURE THEIR ACADEMIC SUCCESS



- See students who are ineligible to participate in their related activities
- Create scheduling constraints to ensure students are being scheduled into applicable courses
- Review a watch list of students who have excessive absences, discipline incidents, and failing grades
- Balance your special education or section 504 students in designated class sections
- Identify Honors and Rewards Eligibility



SCHEDULING CONSTRAINTS & CLASS BALANCING

Create a student threshold scheduling constraint for students who need to receive a specific grade mark and/or GPA in entry-level course to be able to take a higher-level course. Or create a constraint for students who need to be of a specific age to take a course like Drivers Education. While student course requests are entered, the students who have received a student threshold constraint must abide to the scheduling constraints rules.

Student Thresholds can be used to define who your special education or section 504 students are to balance course section class rosters. For example, if you want to define that a specific course section can hold 10% of special education students, class balancing can be used.

STUDENT WATCH LISTS

Need to identify students who have a specific amount of discipline, attendance, and/or grade marks? Student thresholds can define these rules. You can tie these student thresholds into the Watchlist area of MTSS to consider if the student should be referred for an intervention plan.

HONORS/REWARDS ELIGIBILITY

Are you looking for students who meet a specific criteria and are eligible for academic recognition? Use student thresholds to generate a list of students who meet the criteria for specific GPAs, specific grade marks, and/or high assessment scores.
